## Minutes of SARA CLUB Meeting of 20 June 2013

## New Business:

- a. Jim Hill, N4MOC, stated that the club repeater (146.715) could be updated with a new controller. The update would permit additional features that cannot be provided by the current repeater controller. A new controller can be acquired for approximately \$200.00. He suggested the membership consider this upgrade and consider it at the nest meeting.
- b. A suggestion was made to postpone the first Saturday meeting of 6 July. A motion was made, seconded, and passed to keep the regular first Saturday meeting as scheduled on 6 July.

The importance of proper message handling: Local operators need practice in message handling, formatting, etc. Leon suggested members start passing practice traffic on our local nets to gain experience in message handling techniques.

Phone-tree notification program.
